

ASPC/AMHR Club of North Texas High Point Members & Horses

This year the ASPC/AMHR Club of North Texas High Point Program is no longer asking our members to pay an extra fee for consideration into the program. It is being offered as part of your membership.

The following categories will be awarded at our first show of the year in 2011 points being based on 2010 N. TX Club's Show Records

Champion Halter Mare: Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over

Champion Halter Stallion: Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over

Champion Gelding: Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over

Champion Performance Pony/Horse: Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over

Champion Amateur: Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over

Champion Youth 13-17: Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over

Champion Youth 12 & Under: Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over

Champion Trainer: Modern, Classic and AMHR Under & Over

Guidelines:

1. Must be a paid current member of the ASPC/AMHR Club of North Texas
2. Members must be current members of ASPC/AMHR
3. Shows will only count if Member's dues are current at the time of the beginning of a show.
Example: if a member joins in June and showed at the April Show, the April show will not count
...any show subsequent to dues being paid will be applied.
4. Member must submit a Nomination Form for their horses or themselves. Remember No Fees!
5. Horses entered must have their OWNER listed as a member of the N. TX Club. Exception being horse's points being tallied for the Trainer's Division.
6. The Foundation Classes are included in "Classic Division"
7. The Modern Pleasure & ASPR Classes are included in the "Modern Division"

Awards will be tallied as follows:

1. *Champion Halter*: Horses will acquire points in Open Halter Classes based on Point System below** Color, Model, Produce of Dam & Get of Sire will not be included. In the event of a tie, the award will be given to the Horse that has shown in the class(s) with the most entries.
2. *Champion Performance Pony/Horse*: Horse's will acquire point in the Open Performance Classes based on Point System below** In the event of a tie, the award will be given to the Horse that has shown in the class(s) with the most entries.
3. *Champion Amateur*: Amateur's will acquire points in Amateur Classes based on Point System below** Each horse that Amateur shows will accumulate separate points. The Amateur will accumulate different sets of points for each horse they show. Their horse with the most points will be considered for the Champion Amateur Award. In the event of a tie, the award will be given to the Amateur/Horse that has shown in the class(s) with the most entries.
4. *Champion Youth 13-17 & 12 & Under*: Youth will acquire points in Youth Classes based on Point System below** Each horse the youth shows will accumulate separate points. The Youth will accumulate different sets of points for each horse they show. Their horse with the most points will be considered for the Champion Youth Award. In the event of a tie, the award will be given to the Youth/Horse that has shown in the class(s) with the most entries.

5. *Champion Trainer*: Trainers will acquire points in all Open Classes (excluding Color, Model, Produce of Dam & Get of Sire) based on Point System below**. All Horses must be entered as “Shown by” the Trainer/Training Facility. Only horses entered to be “Shown by” Trainer/Training Facility will be considered. Facility’s classes will count towards their collective score in a division. Example: All of the Under Miniatures shown will accumulate points in the Miniature A Division (whether it be halter or performance)...Each horse shown in this division by the Trainer/Training Facility will have a Single Score. Then each horse’s Single Score will be added to create the Trainer/Training Facility’s Collective Score. The points for the Trainer/Training Facility’s “Show” will be an average of the Collective Score in the chosen division. The Collective Score will be divided by the number of horses/ponies the Trainer/Training Facility showed at one show in their chosen division. Winners shall be those with the highest number of points in each division. In the event of a tie, the award will be given to the Trainer/Training Facility that has shown in the class(s) with the most entries.
